THE SECOND LANGUAGE POETRY CONTEST IN 7 LANGUAGES

IN ENGLISH, HUNGARIAN, ITALIAN, GERMAN, FRENCH, SPANISH AND CHINESE

Write a poem in a language other than your mother tongue and enter the CAW Poetry Contest.

ELIGIBILITY: The Poetry Contest is open to all members of the CEU community, (students, faculty, staff, researchers) and visitors taking CAW foreign language courses this term.

SUBMISSION: You may submit one poem per language (that is not written in your mother tongue) on any subject and in any style, provided that the content of the poem is not vulgar or offensive and is your original, individual work and does not exceed 500 words.

The poem should be sent to <u>poetry_contest@ceu.edu</u> from your CEU email address. Visitors attending CAW foreign language courses should use the email address they provided us with when they registered for the course.

When emailing your entry, please enter the poem's title into the subject line, send your poem in a Word or PDF attachment, not containing your name and provide us with a pseudonym that will be used during the contest.

By submitting a poem you accept that the submissions will be published on the CAW Poetry Contest website at https://caw.ceu.edu/poetry_contest under a pseudonym.

CONTEST DATES: November 30, 2015 – January 25, 2016

DECISIONS: Committees will be formed for every language and will consist of a CAW teacher, a student and an alum. This committee will select the best, the second

best and the third best entry per language, based on originality, creativity, and artistic quality. All decisions made by the committees are final.

The CEU community can also vote for the best poems published on the Poetry Contest web page, for one poem per language, by sending us an email from their CEU email address with the poem's title. The entrants whose poems receive the most votes per language will receive a Readers' Choice Award.

Poems containing vulgarity or offensive material are automatically disqualified.

All poems entering the contest (unless inappropriate for some reason) will be published on our website with your pseudonym. When the contest ends and decisions have been made, upon request we change the pseudonym to the entrant's real name.

Winners are announced on February 19, 2016. Winners are notified by email.

PRIZES: The best three poems per language will be rewarded by a certificate and a box of chocolate. Also a certificate and a box of chocolate will be given to the writers of the poems winning the Readers' Choice Award.

PUBLICATION: By submitting a poem to our contest you accept that your poem will appear online, under a pseudonym. We reserve the right to not publish a poem for any reason.
